STATE FRESHWATER CHAMPIONSHIPS 2013 RESULTS

The State Freshwater Titles, hosted by the Ipswich Amateur Fishing Clubs Association, were held at Leslie Dam, outside Warwick, on Saturday and Sunday, 23 & 24 March, in near perfect weather conditions, though the fish were not as co-operative as they have been on previous weekends this year. **38 anglers caught 88 fish, mostly golden perch, for 70.6 kg**, but there were some large ell-tailed catfish caught as well. Most of the catfish were kept alive and returned to the water once they had been weighed.

A great breakfast of bacon, eggs, sausages, hash browns, grilled tomato and onions was enjoyed by all.
